

BOOKING CONDITIONS

- BOOKING** Please book by telephone to the Office with approximate numbers.
- PAYMENT** A non-refundable deposit of £120.00 (inclusive of VAT) to secure a booking and balance paid in cash, cheque or credit card on the date booked.
- NUMBERS** Exact numbers must be advised at least 5 working days prior to the date booked by telephone to the Office on 020 8866 0963. Failure to advise Office of exact numbers at the stipulated time, will result in an invoice being calculated on the approximate number or the number who play, whichever the greater. Once exact numbers are advised your invoice must be settled before you leave the Golf Club either by cash, cheque or credit card at the Bar as previously stated.
- CANCELLATION** Cancellation can only be accepted in writing to the Office up to two weeks before the date booked. After this the Society is liable for the full amount outstanding.
- CLUBHOUSE** The facilities of the Clubhouse will be open to all members of visiting Societies from 0800 hours. Each Society can be issued with a security number for their particular date, which will permit access to the rear door leading to the Locker Rooms and Clubhouse. Mobile telephones are not permitted in the Clubhouse.
- DRESS REGULATIONS** Details are as on the attached headed Dress Regulations and by order of the Directors of the Club will be strictly applied. PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL MEMBERS OF YOUR SOCIETY ARE AWARE OF THESE TO SAVE ANY EMBARRASSMENT.
- COURSE** Wide wheeled trolleys are only permitted as we have found, through experience, that narrow wheeled trolleys cause excessive damage to the course, particularly during wet weather. Buggies are available for hire from the Professional Shop and may be used subject to course conditions. Mobile telephones are not permitted on the course except in an emergency.
- STARTING TIME** Starting times will be allocated by the Office. In this regard the Society organiser is asked to ensure that these times are strictly adhered to. Starting times are controlled at the Professional Shop.
- STANDARD OF PLAY** ALL MEMBERS OF SOCIETYS TO BE BONA-FIDE GOLFERS) and have an official Club or Society Handicap.
- SLOW PLAY** The co-operation of all visitors in avoiding slow play is required. Golfers should play a provisional ball whenever it is likely that there may be some difficulty in finding the first ball struck. Each 9 holes should be completed in under 2 hours.
- GENERAL** Societies are asked to please observe the etiquette of Golf, as contained in Section 1 of the "Rules of Golf".
- FINALLY** All the staff of Pinner Hill Golf Club are here to ensure you have an enjoyable day. Please do not hesitate to ask if you need any further assistance.
